**ECB CHECKLIST FOR PLAYERS INVOLVED IN RECREATIONAL CRICKET
(As at 24th July 2020)**

To remain in line with current ECB COVID-19 guidelines you must ensure that –

- You do not attend if you are displaying any symptoms or are required to isolate. Please contact your captain ASAP so they can find a replacement player.
- You turn up ready to play as changing rooms will be shut before, during and after the game.
- You do not share equipment.
- You do not apply sweat or saliva to the ball.
- You bring any food and drink you wish to consume during the game as no teas are provided.
- You always remain socially distanced, including during the game.
- You comply with track and trace protocols.
- You have your own supply of hand sanitiser.
- In addition, the Captain of the day, or a nominee, will be responsible for cleaning the match ball with sanitiser after every six overs or at the request of the umpires.

Reminders of our general Club guidance for playing at home are listed below. If you are selected to play away, then you may receive an additional e-mail with guidance from that Club. You must ensure you stay within the guidance to protect the good name of our Club. Disciplinary measures may be taken for any reported breaches.

Please find below the specific plans and guidance we have in place at the current time –

Parking – Car parking is available at the ground.

Club Entrance – Entrance to the ground is via Cricketfield Road.

Club Exit – Exit from the ground is also via Cricketfield Road.

Changing Rooms – These will remain shut and locked during the day.

Kit – Whilst the game is In progress players can leave their kit in the designated players' area or In their own cars.

Bar – Our bar will be open during the game and will be serving drinks only. All players must follow the protocols as set out by the bar management.

Teas – There will be no teas provided on the day. However, refreshments can be purchased from the food outlet adjacent to the Club pavilion.

Spectators – The Club welcome friends or family as spectators but please remind them to socially distance and not to touch the ball at any time. They must not attend if they display any symptoms. They can park in the Club car park and please remind them to bring their own supplies of sanitiser.

Inclement Weather – In the result of delays due to rain, players and spectators should shelter in their cars and not try to enter the Club House.

Conduct – All players must respect the above points and comply with our test and trace procedure. If you do not comply with our guidance, then you may be asked to leave the Club on the day and face subsequent disciplinary action.
